








Commuting stations


Exchange culture with Japanese Students

Course Details

Prep Course for Further Education (Monday-Friday 20 lessons /week 10 weeks/semester)

This course is the preparation course for students who would like to apply for Japanese college, university, or vocational school courses. Acquiring the basic knowledge required for attending university lectures is also a part of this course.

Intensive course (Monday-Friday 20 lessons/week 10 weeks/semester)

This course is designed to improve all aspects of the Japanese language. It balances speaking, listening, reading and writing, while reinforcing grammar and vocabulary. The level is divided into nine instructions from elementary to advanced.

Conversation course (Monday-Friday 20 lessons/week 12 weeks/semester)

This course focuses on grammar, vocabulary, Japanese culture and customs to improve your communication skills with confidence.

Hiragana / Katakana course (Monday-Friday 20 lessons/week 4-week program)

This course is for total beginners. It concentrates on Hiragana/Katakana, as well as on basic grammar and conversation.

Private lessons (Monday-Friday 9:00 — 20:00 1 lesson/90 or 120 minutes)

This lesson is suitable for all levels and needs. It is a fast and effective way to improve language skills.

In-House lesson (Monday-Friday 9:00 — 20:00 1 lesson/ 90 or 120 minutes)

Our experienced teachers can teach a variety of levels, from basic Japanese to Business Japanese in private or group lessons at offices or other workplaces.
