What is Edo Cultural Center?

Edo Cultural Center Japanese Language School was founded in 1984. Since then, more than 10,000 students from over 70 countries have completed our courses. Long-Term Student Visa Course

If you would like to study the Japanese language for more than 6 months in Japan you can try to apply for the Student Visa.

Preparatory Course (students who aim to enroll higher education in Japan after graduated) and General Course (students who aim to get a job in Japan or back to their own country after graduated) is available.






